Background:

Through the construction of the **Philip and Susan Ragan Building** at Massachusetts General Hospital, more than \$62 million in **Determination of Need (DoN)** funding has been made available to support community health initiatives.

These Community Health Impact Funds (CHIF) present a unique opportunity to partner with community organizations in advancing sustainable, long-term improvements in the health and well-being of the communities we serve. Through this investment, we aim to support innovative, community-driven solutions that address key health and social needs while fostering lasting impact.

Mass General Brigham Ambulatory Surgery-Cambridge Project

This funding opportunity is a smaller, geographically focused initiative with a defined applicant pool. Because of its specific geographic scope, program design, and available funding, eligible organizations are contacted directly and provided with instructions for submitting an Application.

Background:

The Mass General Brigham Ambulatory Surgery – Cambridge is a joint venture between MGB and Regent Surgical Health. This project is for the creation of a freestanding single-specialty ambulatory surgery center (ASC) to be located at 799 Concord Ave., Cambridge, MA 02138.

The Proposed Project will allow MGB to decrease waiting times for patients needing routine screenings and to shift routine screenings that are currently performed at MGH and Brigham Women's Hospital (BWH) to a more convenient, cost-effective setting improving access and throughput for cases that must be performed in the hospital setting.
