In 2022, Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) began construction on a state-of-the-art clinical building in Boston—the Phillip and Susan Ragon Building. This capital expenditure triggered the largest ever Determination of Need (DoN) process in Massachusetts history, resulting in a \$62M dollar investment in the communities that Mass General Brigham serves. The MGH Community Advisory Board (CAB), guided by the community driven 2022-23 Community Health Needs Assessment and Community Health Implementation Plan, has determined four funding priorities along with the strategies to tackle them—housing, economic/financial stability and mobility, mental/behavioral health, and food/nutrition security. Each priority will have its own Allocation Committee. Requests for proposals for funding dedicated to housing were released on November 1, 2023, and final proposals are now under review.

We are now excited to announce a **\$3M** dollar funding opportunity for organizations working on economic mobility and financial stability.

Poverty and economic stability directly affect the social determinants of health (SDOH)-those social and economic factors that have an enormous impact on a person’s health and wellbeing. Strategies that improve access to employment and education are crucial for reducing poverty, improving overall health status, and enhancing the quality of life for individuals and communities.


